SUPPORTING YOUTH SELF-EMPLOYMENT

One of the major societal challenges affecting the European Union is combating the significant youth unemployment. In order to respond to this important and demanding task, the Regional Union of Municipalities of Attica (P.E.D.A.) in collaboration with the European Network for Inclusion and Local Social Action (E.L.I.S.A.N) and with the support of Regioeuropa, the European Network of Social Action (E.N.S.A.), the European Youth Care Platform, the Regione Veneto, the Veneto Lavoro, the Land of Carinthia, the Polibienestar of Valencia and the CCAS of Marseille, launched a call for awards to 'European Best Practices Supporting Youth Self-Employment'.

This initiative aimed to enhance original, relevant and innovative actions which further eased the access to self-employment by overcoming the existing barriers, by developing the entrepreneurial culture and encouraging young people to engage in entrepreneurship in order to tackle their own unemployment and create their own jobs.

This call for awards was directed to Ministries, Municipalities and Regions, private or public entities such as universities/colleges, youth organizations and social partners, vocational training centres, professional and scientific organizations. The overall selected applications were 27 from which 14 were selected for final evaluation of the jury. During the "European Conference on Youth Self-Employment" organised by P.E.D.A and E.L.I.S.A.N. on the 10-11th of November 2016 in Athens, Greece, 6 prizes have been awarded.

"EGG-ENTER GROW GO" aims to support youth innovative entrepreneurship and improve sustainable employment opportunities in Greece, especially for young people. The Project provides teams of young entrepreneurs with an integrated framework of business incubation, acceleration and coworking space by offering them a range of supporting actions and tools that help them transform their business plans, original ideas or prototypes, into complete, marketable products and services.



Santander International Entrepreneurship Center (CISE) – Santander, Northern Spain

The Project's main objective is to boost entrepreneurial ventures of young people through a collaborative ecosystem that promotes synergies and knowledge transfer among YUZZ participants and entrepreneurial experts, business mentors, investors and training professionals. The Project runs simultaneously at currently 48 YUZZ Centers distributed through Spain.



Labour Policies Deparment – Municipality of Vicenza, Italy

"Cercando il lavoro" aims to give support to unemployed people by creating a network between public and private stakeholders involved in the labor market. Among its partners are: the Association of Labor Consultants, professional educators, training companies, recruitment agencies, job experts and advisors, head hunters and private companies' hiring managers. Through "Cercando il lavoro" a network of 14 municipalities was created to share both target group as well as professionals and job experts. After 4 years, the network has been enlarged to 21 municipalities.

It also creates savings on the public expenditure and at the same time, more wealth (economic stimulus), health, social networks and less criminality.




