# Encouraging entrepreneurship and self-employment

50€ Flat rate

Objective	Favouring self-employment among young people
Target group	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Men until 30 years old</li><li>Women and disabled people until 35 years old</li></ul>
Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>age, not have been self-employed before and not having any employee.</li></ul>
Description	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Reduction in the self-employment fee</li></ul>

Male until 30 years old	Duration	6 months	6 months	18 months
Female until 35 years old	Deduction	80%	50%	30%
Disabled people	Duration	12 months	4 years	
	Deduction	80%	50%	

# To sum up



## Positive:

- Way to keep youth talent
- Cut down on the youth unemployment
- Increase the number of companies



## Negative:

- Little involvement of target groups in the formulation (top to the bottom policy)
- Resources
- Indicators to measure the impact of the policy
- There is no bidirectional communication between levels of the administration

## Uncertain:

- Limited impact because of the crisis
- Economic resources?
- It's not only to set up a business
