

Encouraging entrepreneurship and self-employment

50€ Flat rate

Objective	Favouring self-employment iamong young people
Target group	 Men until 30 years old Women and disabled people until 35 years old
Requirements	 age, not have been self-employed before and not having any employee.
Description	Reduction in the self-employment fee
	Male until 30 years old Duration 6 months 6 months 18 months
	Female until 35 years old Deduction 80% 50% 30%
	Disabled people Duration 12 months 4 years

To sum up
